

Terms of Participation in the Guest Survey Contest

1. Organizer

The contest is organized by Emmentaler Schaukäserei AG, Schaukäsereistrasse 6, 3416 Affoltern i.E., hereinafter referred to as "ESK."

2. Eligibility

All natural persons aged 18 and over who provide their email address in the survey and confirm their interest in the contest are eligible to participate. Employees of the company are excluded from participation. By entering the contest, participants accept these terms and conditions.

3. Participation Period

Participation is possible throughout the year. The prize is drawn randomly at the end of each quarter (March, June, September, December).

4. Prize

The prize consists of a voucher worth CHF 50.00 per quarter. A cash payout or transfer to another person is possible.

5. Winner Notification and Prize Delivery

The winner will be notified via email after the participation period ends. If the winner does not respond within 3 days of notification, the prize will be forfeited, and a new winner will be selected. The prize will be sent within 7 days after confirmation of the prize notification.

6. Data Protection

The email addresses provided will be used exclusively for conducting the contest and sending information about other offers from ESK, provided that participants have given explicit consent. Without such consent, the data will be deleted after the contest ends. The data will not be shared with third parties. Further information can be found in our <u>privacy policy</u>.

7. Liability

ESK assumes no liability for technical problems or for any losses arising from the dispatch of winner notifications or the acceptance of the prize. Likewise, no liability is assumed for delays or the inaccessibility of the website.

8. Exclusion from the Contest

ESK reserves the right to exclude any participant without providing reasons if they violate these terms and conditions or attempt to manipulate the contest.

9. Changes to the Terms and Conditions

ESK reserves the right to modify or terminate the contest at any time without providing reasons.

10. Legal Recourse

Legal recourse is excluded. Swiss law applies.
